

Scott County Building Official

The Building Official is responsible for administration of the Minnesota State Building Code, including department staffing, code enforcement, development of policy & procedures, permit processing, plan review, building inspections, & the issuance of certificates of occupancy for code compliant buildings & structures in the townships of Scott County. Provides for minimum requirements to safeguard the public health, safety, & general welfare throughout code compliant buildings & structures. **MQs:** Requires State of Minnesota Building Official Certification, plus a total of five years of building construction or building inspections experience, of which two years must be building inspections experience, administering the State Building codes. Must be able to obtain Minnesota Incident Management System (MnIMS) certification within 12 months of hire. Preference given for supervisory experience, International Code Council (ICC) Building Inspector certification, ICC Mechanical Inspector certification, ICC Plumbing Inspector certification, & ICC Plans Examiner certification.
